- ★ 5 different stamps (3 from Newquay or Par and 2 from branch line pubs) to claim your Window Sticker.
- ★ 10 different stamps (6 from Newquay or Par and 4 from branch line pubs) to claim your Tourshirt and Window Sticker.
- ★ Collect all 16 stamps to claim your Tourshirt, Window Sticker and Enamel Badge.
