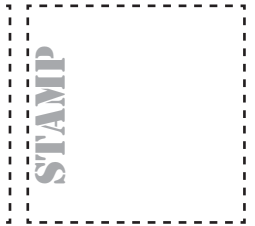

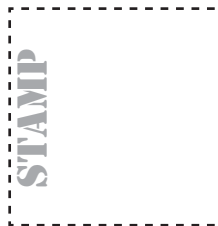

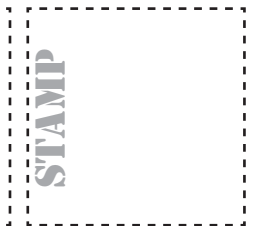

Rules for claiming Rail Ale Trail Souvenirs

- ★ Collect all 14 stamps to claim your Tourshirt, Window Sticker and Enamel Badge.

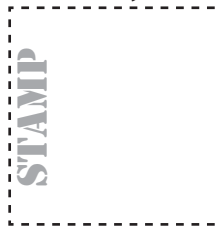
